Friday arrived so Duncan G4PKO and myself along with tents etc headed for the hills, hotly persued by Alan G4EFP and John G8UZZ and others.


After erecting the tents (We got better with practice) an adjournment to the nearest (3 miles) 'Watering Hole' was proposed and 'Carried Unanimously'
