He passed it on to York District Hospital, which contacted the manufacturers and the drug was later handed to cabin staff on a Yugoslav airline flight from London last night.

Amateur involvement in the Olympics is progressing well, with plans now firm to have Amateur RF stations operating from all three Olympic Villages. Tentative agreements are already well along with a number of countries to waive their restrictions on third-party traffic, to enable their Olympic athletes to keep in touch with home via Amateur Radio.
