Directions to Irby Cricket Club, Mill Hill Road, Irby.

FROM LIVERPOOL - USING THE NEW WALLASEY TUNNEL.

Leave the Tunnel exit toll booths and join the M53 mid-Wirral motorway.

Note speed limit of 40 mph rising to 50 mph over the Bidston Moss fly-over. On leaving the fly-over the motorway speed de-restriction signs appear. Prepare to leave the motorway at the next exit, so **follow the two left hand lanes (which is Junction 2**) for Upton, Hoylake & Greasby. This two lane spur then takes a sharp right hand turn over the M53 motorway and continues for about 1 mile. **Stay on to the end of the spur which terminates in a roundabout.**

Cross over the roundabout onto the A5027 sign posted Birkenhead. The road bends round to your left where in about a 100 yards there are traffic and pedestrian lights. Continue on through all these lights staying on the same road till you reach a roundabout in about 1 mile.

Take a right turn at this roundabout (marked Greasby, Frankby, West Kirby) onto the B5139 Greasby Road passing the Premier Lodge and Twelth Man Public House on your left. Continue, and you pass a small group of shops on your right (and through a Zebra Lights Crossing). After the BP garage on your right, you want the second road on your left. The first is Circular Drive and the second is **Greasby Road**.

Turn left into Greasby Road which is only 100 yards long, but it takes you through to a T junction with Arrowe Road where you **turn right** (opposite the Cabbage Patch shop). A small group of shops will be on your left and you continue for 200 yds. As the road goes into an S bend by the Manor Restaurant on your right, prepare to **turn left into Mill Lane** just past the "Puck Racing" betting shop.

Follow Mill Lane slowly climbing for just over a mile until you reach a roundabout with the Irby Mill public house on your right. **Over this small roundabout** takes you into Mill Hill Road. After climbing for about 100 yards you will see a lay-by on your left. (which is easy to miss in the dark).

Turn into this lay-by and immediately on your left is the gate entrance to the Irby Cricket Club.

Turn in, and drive down to and pass the Club house turning right and park in the car park by the mobile phone mast.
